INTRODUCTION

At its June 1982 meeting the Council took note of an Executive Committee discussion of Council's role in the presentation and promotion of the work of Canadian artists in foreign countries. In response to a request from the Council, "management agreed to develop a document for Council outlining our current involvement, and including recommendations for the future, with present and anticipated costs". The following report represents the descriptive component of the promised document. This report does not consider what the Canada Council should be doing in the way of international representation. Rather it outlines the scale and scope of international Canadian artistic activity supported by the Canada Council during 1980-81 and 1981-82.

Methodology

Definition of Terms

The first task involved was defining international Canadian artistic activities supported by Council. In a sense all Council activity contributes to the international recognition of Canadian art and artists. Such an all encompassing definition, however, would render a special inventory meaningless. Nevertheless a relatively broad definition of international activity is used in this report. Specifically, any activity which directly contributes to the exposure of Canadian art or artists to non-Canadians is included, regardless of whether that activity takes place abroad or in Canada or whether a grant is made to a Canadian or to a foreign artist or organization. As a result support of activities taking place within Canada which involve artistic interaction between Canadians and foreigners is included. For instance, international conferences and symposia held in Canada are treated as qualifying activities and grants to Canadians or non-Canadians to attend such events are included. Similarly, grants to Canadian cultural organizations for foreign visiting artists are included because support is normally given for foreigners to instruct at Canadian arts institutions. Teaching by definition involves artistic interaction between instructor and pupils and exposes the former to Canadian artistic standards. On the other hand, grants to foreigners to perform in Canada are not included because there is no direct artistic interaction between foreign and Canadian artists except as members of an audience. Grants to Canadians to perform abroad or to perform at international gatherings, however, qualify. Furthermore all activities of the Canadian Commission for UNESCO have been excluded.

Data Sources

For Aid to Individuals, administered by the Awards Section, application of the definition of international activity was simple. Any grant with foreign tenure, i.e. for an activity to be carried out abroad, is included. Using this criteria a list of relevant grants, with the exception of those awarded under the program of Grants for International Representation (GRIPE), was extracted from the computerized Financial Management System. Data on the GRIPE program was obtained from Canada Council agenda books.

In the case of Aid to Organizations, administered by the Arts Sections, identification of relevant activity was more difficult. Because of the wide range of activities it was necessary to examine the agenda books for every Canada Council meeting held during the two fiscal years under examination. Using descriptions contained in the agenda books grants which qualified and which could be costed were identified. Only grants for which international activity was the sole or a specific purpose of a project or activity are included.

This restriction was necessary so that international artistic activity supported by the Canada Council could be costed. As a result, Operating Grants, because of their general nature, were, with few exceptions, excluded. It is important to bear in mind, however, that many client organizations, particularly service organizations, carry out important international activities as part of their operating mandate. In contributing to the operations of these organizations, the Canada Council facilitates international activity. Touring grants are included even though foreign performances are not supported by the Touring Office. Relevant touring grants and the foreign country in which performances took place are displayed because such performances would not, in most cases, take place without the grant for the Canadian portion of the tour. However, only those foreign performances for which specific costs could be identified are included in the financial aggregates. Hence most touring grants are excluded.

Costing of Activities

Support of international activity is displayed in gross terms. In most cases this means the full grant amount, including any allowances or extra payments. In the case of programs operated by the Canada Council in conjunction with the Department of External Affairs, expenditure by Council is included regardless of whether or not Council is reimbursed. For example, in the Visiting Foreign Artists Program, External Affairs provides the Canada Council with a lump sum payment for administering the program, currently \$75,000 per annum. From this payment Council uses 10% for administrative purposes and the remainder to award stipends to grantees. The Council also pays the travel costs of some grantees from its own funds. In the inventory stipends paid by External Affairs and the travel costs paid by Council are displayed separately. Both are included in the financial aggregates.

While the full grant amount is accounted for, only direct support are displayed. Delivery costs such as adjudication could not be readily identified for most grants. Accordingly, all delivery costs are excluded in the financial aggregates. It should be noted that in some cases delivery costs are as large as the grant itself. For example, in the Canada-Switzerland Literary Prize the Canada Council awards, every second year, a prize of \$2,500 to a Swiss writer. In 1980-81 the delivery costs, primarily adjudication, amounted to \$3,116. Only the value of the prize itself is included in the inventory. Similarly, the administrative costs of operating the Visiting Foreign Artists Program are excluded.

In the case of some programs operated conjointly with External Affairs, the Canada Council incurs only delivery costs. For example, Council adjudicates the Canada-Belgium and Canada-Australia Literary Prizes for External Affairs which generally pays the prize directly itself. Similarly, the Council carries out adjudication for places at the Artists' Studios at Cite Internationale des Arts in Paris. The costs of maintaining the studios are paid by External Affairs. The Paris studios, like the two literary prizes noted above, are not included in the inventory because only delivery costs are involved.

Definition of Fiscal Year

Grants are displayed in the inventory under the fiscal year in which they were reported to Council. This practice was adopted in order to use Council agenda books, the best data source concerning Aid to Organizations. Because Council approval is required for most grants, this date normally corresponds to the fiscal year in which grants were approved. In several instances, however, particularly

Officer's grants, the year of approval and the year of reporting may differ. For example, Officer's grants approved in the latter half of March - and such grants are quite numerous - are not reported until June of the next fiscal year. As a result, and due to other accounting anomalies, data displayed in the inventory may not agree with that reported in the Financial Management System.

FOREGROUND TABLES

Foreground tables were developed from the background tables and inventories of grants. Foreground tables display the number and value of Canada Council grants in support to international Canadian artistic activity in fiscal years 1980-81 and 1981-82. Two tables are presented:

Table 1: Summary of Support by Discipline which displays data concerning support to individual artists, grants for international representation (GRIPES) and arts organizations for ten artistic disciplines including: Arts Administration, Dance, Film, Multimedia, Music, Performance Art, Theatre, Video, Visual Arts, and Writing.

Table 2: Summary of Support by Country which displays data concerning support to individual artists, grants for international representation (GRIPES) and arts organizations for the forty countries in which the international artistic activity supported by the Canada Council took place.

For purposes of the tables grants applicable to more than one discipline or more than one country have been treated as multiple grants. The dollar value of such grants have been pro-rated by discipline or country. For example, in 1981-82 a grant of \$35,000 classified as Multimedia, was given to the Canadian Mediterranean Institute to provide services in Italy, Greece and Egypt. In the financial aggregates this grant is reported as three grants of \$11,667 to each of Italy, Greece, and Egypt. In the aggregates by discipline this same grant was treated as three Multimedia grants worth a total of \$35,000.

BACKGROUND TABLES & INVENTORIES

Background tables and inventories have been developed from the financial management system and Council agenda books. Both tables and inventories display significantly greater detail than foreground tables. There are five background tables and two inventories. These include:

The Tables

Table 1: Support to Individuals by Discipline by Program which displays data for the ten artistic disciplines for each of the five major types of grants in Aid to Individuals, excluding GRIPE, i.e. "A" Grants, "B" Grants, Short-Term Grants, Project Cost Grants, and Travel Grants.

Table 2: Support to Individuals by Country by Program which displays data for forty foreign countries for each of the five major types of grants in Aid to Individuals, excluding GRIPE, i.e., "A" Grants, "B" Grants, Short-Term Grants, Project Cost Grants, and Travel Grants.

Table 3: Support to Individuals By Discipline by Country by Program which displays data for each artistic discipline for each foreign country for each of the five major types of grants in Aid to Individuals, excluding GRIPE, i.e., "A" Grants, "B" Grants, Short-Term Grants, Project Cost Grants, and Travel Grants.

Table 4: Support to Organizations by Discipline by Program which displays data for the nine disciplines used for categorization, i.e., Dance, Film, Multimedia, Music, Performance Art, Theatre, Video, Visual Arts, and Writing for each of the four major types of grants in Aid to Organizations, as reported in Trends in Canada Council Support to the Arts, i.e. Operating Grants, Project Grants, Other Grants, and Touring Grants.

Table 5: Support to Organizations by Country by Program which displays data for each foreign country for each of the four major types of grants in Aid to Organizations, as reported in Trends in Canada Council Support to the Arts, i.e. Operating Grants, Project Grants, Other Grants, and Touring Grants.

For purposes of the tables grants applicable to more than one discipline or more than one country have been treated as multiple grants. The dollar value of such grants have been pro-rated by discipline or country.

The Inventories

Two inventories of grants in support to international Canadian artistic activity are presented in the background of the report. The first concerns Grants for International Representation (GRIPE) and the second concerns support to artistic organizations.

GRIPE

Although part of the Awards program, GRIPE has been shown separately. The inventory reports grants awarded in seven disciplines, i.e. Arts Administration, Dance, Multimedia, Music, Theatre, Visual Arts and Writing. For each grant the inventory provides the following information: Discipline; Type which for GRIPE is classed as Other; Grantee, normally a member of the Canadian branch of an international organization; Purpose, normally to attend a general meeting of an international organization; Country in which the meeting is held; C.C. Mtg. (Canada Council meeting) at which grants were reported; Amount including travel and subsistence allowances.

Organizations

A detailed inventory of international Canadian artistic activity supported by the Canada Council through grants to organizations is also provided. The inventory is arranged by the nine disciplines for which support was given. For each grant the inventory provides the following information: Discipline; Type, either Operating, Project, Touring or Other; Grantee; Purpose; Country in which an activity took place or towards which the grant was directed; C.C. Mtg. (Canada Council meeting) at which grants were reported; and Amount.

FINDINGS

Findings are drawn from the Foreground Tables and from the most recent edition of Trends in Canada Council Support to the Arts covering the period 1971-72 to 1980-81. Findings are reported under two headings. First, the scale of international Canadian artistic activity supported by the Canada Council in 1980-81 is compared with total support by discipline. Second, the distribution of international Canadian activity supported by Canada Council is reported according to country.

Scale of International Canadian Artistic Activity

In 1980-81, the Canada Council provided a total of 410 grants worth more than \$2 million in support to international Canadian artistic activity. This represented 2.3% of total Canada Council support to the arts. In 1981-82, support to international Canadian artistic activity increased to 492 grants worth more than \$2.5 million. No estimate of total Canada Council support is yet available for the 1981-82 fiscal year. Accordingly the subsequent findings are based upon fiscal year 1980-81.

In 1980-81, the Canada Council provided 303 grants worth almost \$1.5 million to individual artists who used their grants abroad. Support to individuals represented 71.2% of total support to international activity. This total excludes GRIPES. Grants in support to the international activities of individual Canadian artists represented 30.2% of total Canada Council support to individual artists. Support to the international activities of Canadian arts organizations in 1980-81 included 91 grants worth \$580,000 or 1.5% of total Council support to arts organizations. Support to organizations represented 27.9% of total support to international activity.

The pattern of support to international artistic activity as a per cent of total discipline support in 1980-81 was as follows:
