

# Introduction

The DutchCulture Database tracks the projects of Dutch makers (creative professionals and cultural organisations) from all artistic disciplines around the globe. Each year we analyse the international activities of Dutch makers in order to shed light on the international impact of Dutch makers.

2024 saw the most activity of any year in the last five years. Makers worked across borders, both physical and conceptual, to collaborate internationally and impactfully. Makers continue to thread their way through today's challenges to float through the current.

To create this mapping and sustain the DutchCulture Database, we work directly with our partners at the Dutch embassies, consulates and cultural funds, and with makers, cultural organisations and professionals.



# 2024 In Review

A dynamic year, filled with 18,141 international activities by 2,902 Dutch makers

Most activities tracked since 2019

Over 600 more activities in 2024 than in 2023 (4% growth)

More than 4,000 new international venues and partners added to the database


More than 1,000 new Dutch makers added to the database

241 different Dutch cities and towns had internationally active makers

22 of the 24 focal countries in Dutch international cultural policy were in the top 50 most popular destinations

EU countries key partners, with 53% of all activities taking place in member states

More than 800 educational activities by Dutch makers



# Cultural Activities in 2024

In 2024, the DutchCulture Database tracked 18,141 cultural activities by Dutch makers around the world. 2,902 Dutch makers from 12 different cultural disciplines collaborated internationally.

In 2024, Dutch makers visited 2,787 cities in 120 countries. The EU remains a strong hub for cultural activity, with roughly half of all activities taking place within EU countries. Likewise, focal countries continue to foster strong cultural participation; 78% of all activities in 2024 took place in a focal country.





In 2024 2,902 Dutch makers worked abroad on cultural projects. These makers hailed from 211 different Dutch cities and towns.




# Disciplines




Sub-discipline breakdown based on number of activities in 2024


